34. Comments on SDG linkages

The resource is focussed on adopting sustainable practices and sustainability reporting (SDG 12.6) and taking climate action (SDG 13.3). These are linked to SDGs 7.2 (uptake of renewable energy) and 7.3 (improving energy efficiency), and 9.4 (upgrading infrastructure to be sustainable), SDGs 12.2 (sustainable use of natural resources), 12.4 (managing wastes into the environment), 12.5 (reducing waste through prevention, reduction, reuse and recycling), and 12.7 (green procurement).
